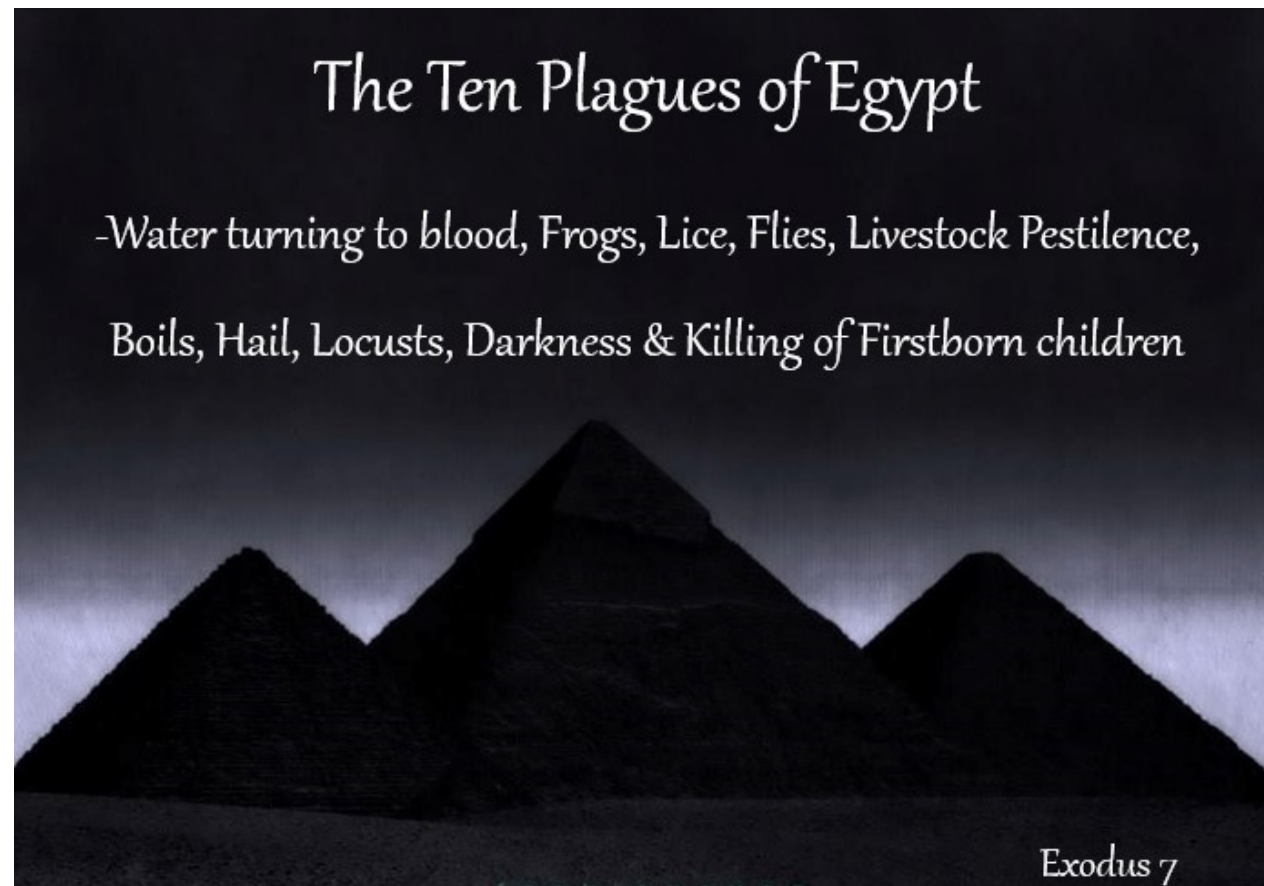

Guys Hangout

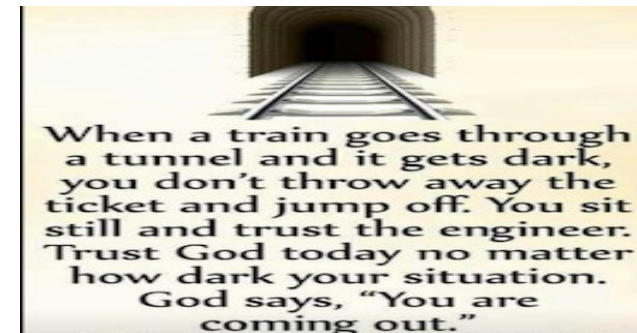
